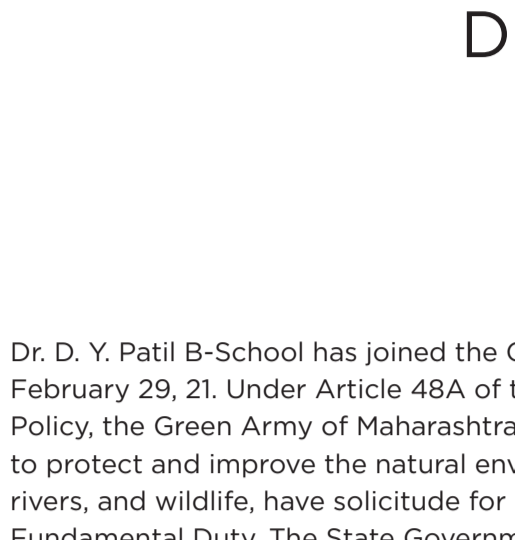

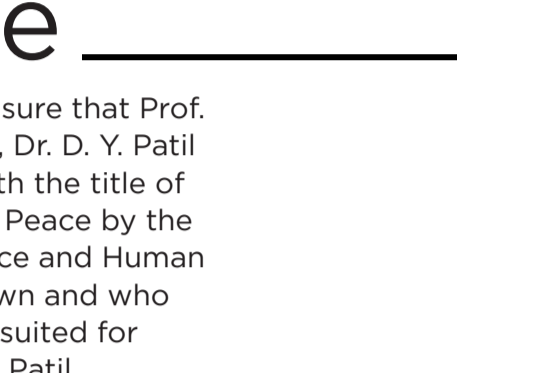

## DR. D. Y. PATIL B-SCHOOL JOINS GREEN ARMY OF MAHARASHTRA

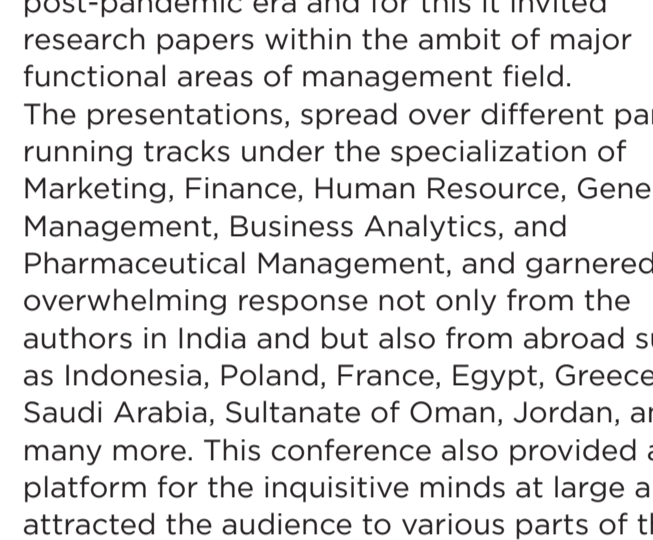

Under Article 48A of the Directive Principles of State Policy, the Green Army of Maharashtra, declares and obliges the citizens to protect and improve the natural environment including forests, lakes, rivers, and wildlife, have solicitude for living creatures and class it as a Fundamental Duty. The State Government of Maharashtra has taken up the 50 crore plantation program intended to increase the forest cover in the state from the current 20% to the nationally mandated 33% of Maharashtra's land area. Insufficient manpower with the Forest Department calls for the formation of the Green Army.

## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE opens a new realm for Creativity and Innovation

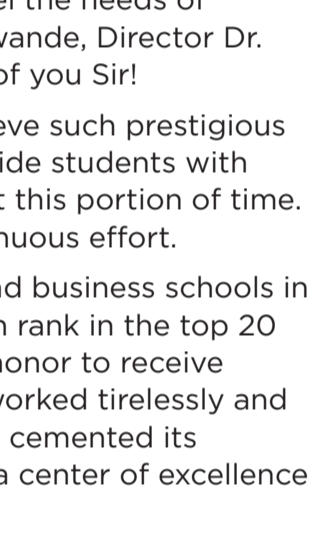
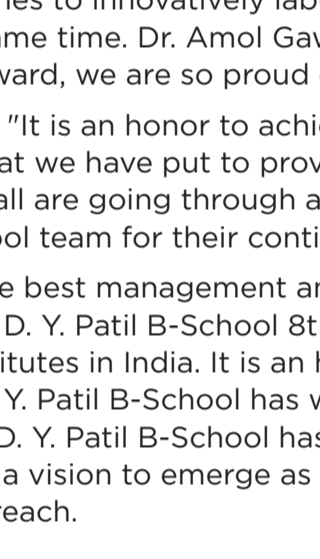
